



## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO SECURE STALLS AT THE 2017 TSHWANE OPEN NIGHT MARKET

### **1. Purpose**

The purpose of this document is to request proposals from different service providers for setting up stalls and providing services or selling products at the Tshwane Open Night Market. The cost of a stall will be R500 for the three nights of 3, 4 and 5 March 2017. Electricity, lights and a gazebo will be provided but the service provider must supply their own tables and chairs.

### **2. Background**

The Tshwane Open Golf Tournament was first launched in 2013, sanctioned by the Sunshine Tour and European Tour. The tournament has since striven to live up to its slogan, "More than just golf". For the past two years, the tournament has hosted a night market that starts on Friday and ends on Sunday. The market presents an opportunity for social cohesion, as people from different communities gather to enjoy music and food, and purchase beautiful crafts and clothing from local small businesses and craftsmen. This is an opportunity for small businesses, artists and crafters to market and sell their products to the crowds that attend the event. The night market attracts over a 1 000 spectators and guests per night, and the number is continually growing.

### **3. Request for proposals**

Service providers are requested to send their proposals to form part of the night market. The proposals must be detailed and clearly state the services that will be rendered or products that will be sold. A detailed company profile with full contact details must be included.
